

FAFSA Verification

Verification is the process your school (college/university) uses to confirm the data reported on your FAFSA form is correct.

If you are selected for verification, your school will request additional documentation that supports the information you reported.

All you need to do is provide the documentation your school asks for – and be sure to do so by the school’s deadline, or you won’t be able to get financial aid!

Next Steps:

1. Contact the financial aid department of the schools you listed on your FAFSA.
2. Determine which documents they need for verification.
 - You may be able to do this all online through your student portal for each school.
3. Submit documents by the financial aid deadline.
